

SPRING BREAK AQUATIC DAYCAMP LEADER

UBC Aquatic Centre Day Camps are looking for Spring Break (Monday, March 18 – Friday, March 22 and Monday, March 25 – Thursday, March 29, 2018) Play and Swim Camp Leaders who have experience working with children (ages 5 to 14 years) in a camp setting with specialty interests in either Aquatics or General Sports. Camps run between 9am and 4pm for a 7 hour day. This position requires leaders to be wet and in the water directly supervising and engaging campers. Instructors will be responsible for: program implementation, supervising groups of youth (ages 5-14 years), teaching swimming skills, delivering recreational activities for children in the water, outside and in the classroom, and assisting with the organization of games and activities.

Remuneration: \$14 to \$15 per hour plus 4% in lieu of benefits.

SPECIFIC DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Implementing and instructing activities/sports/crafts
- Supervising camp participants (ages ranging from 5-14)
- Ensuring safety of all camp participants
- Signing in and out camp participants
- Escorting campers to and from campus facilities, off sight venues and local playgrounds
- Takes direction from a Senior Daycamp Leader and/or Daycamp Supervisor
